Emmett Verdecchia is the Vice President of Surgical Services. Emmett assumed responsibility for all surgical services at Hamot Medical Center, the Hamot Surgery Center and the new Hamot Women's Hospital in December 2009.

In this position, he oversees the day-to-day operations for the following functions as they relate to the surgical service line: operating room, anesthesia, supply chain, information systems, perfusion, finance, quality and pre-admission testing.

Additionally, Emmett and his team works closely with each service line leader at Hamot to ensure the highest-quality care for our surgical patients.

Emmett joined Hamot in May 2001. Since July 2004, he has served as the administrative director of the Hamot Surgery Center.
