You may consider talking to your doctor about home care if any of the following are identified:

- Trouble breathing
- Trouble ambulating
- Irregular heartbeat/chest pain
- Dizziness
- Confusion
- Visually impaired
- New onset weakness
- Recent surgery (open-heart, orthopaedic, general)
- Drains / Foleys
- New diabetes diagnosis
- New insulin start
- Wound care
- Tube feedings
- Infusion need: TPN, antibiotic, hydration, pain management, lovenox, etc. . . .
- High or low blood pressure
- Trachestomy
- Ostomy
- Nephrostomy
- Urine retention / catheter
- Vent dependent
- Recent falls
- Pain
- Excessive Nausea / Vomiting
- Dehydration
- Nutrition deficiency
- Recurrent hospital or ED admissions
- Debility
- Live alone
